



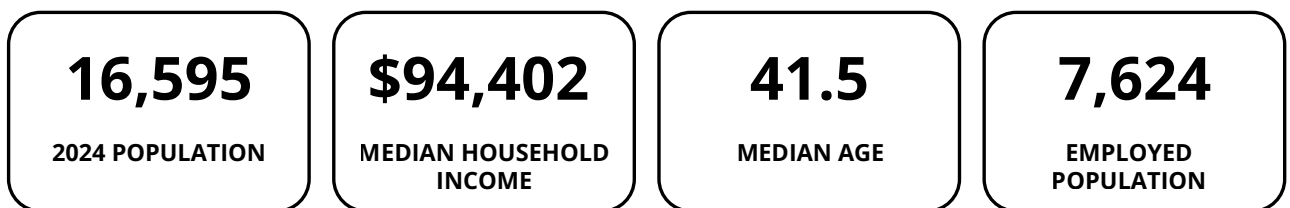
Starting a Business in Morton

Why Morton, Illinois?

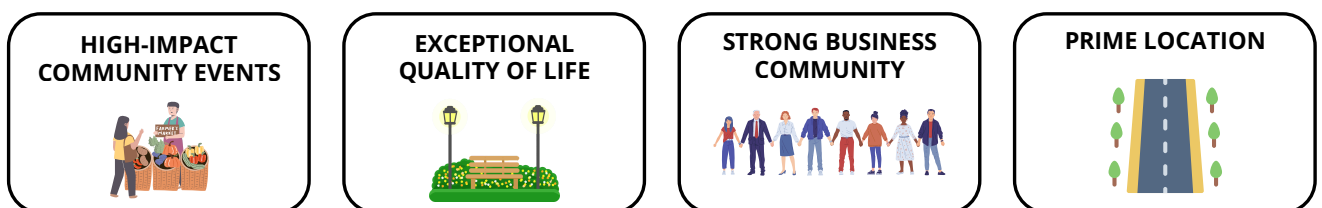
